## St. Bede's Episcopal Day School

**Outreach Ministries** are an important part of **St. Bede's Day School**. We use the following three ministries in association with St. Bede's Episcopal Church to teach the children about giving to others.

### **Emmaus House Community**

St. Bede's Day School helps provide food at thanksgiving for one of the poorest neighborhoods in the metropolitan area.

### **Baby Jesus Baskets**

At Christmas time the school donates new baby clothes and items for babies born during the holidays. These items are distributed through Grady hospital to mothers who need assistance.

### **Operation School Bell**

This ministry helps provide the poorest school children in our area with clothes and basic supplies. We ask the children to help by bringing in new toothbrushes during February. This ties together nicely with our pajama day theme.

## Purpose

St. Bede's Episcopal Day School, which began in 1963, was established as a non-profit pre-school to serve the Northlake/Tucker area of Atlanta. Our school's purpose is to prepare preschool children socially and scholastically for the transition from home to school in a Christian environment. The school aims to provide an atmosphere to help the child move out from parental dependence toward a balance of self-reliance and God-reliance. The program is designed to meet the basic needs of love, trust and discipline, while learning basic skills and concepts in a pre-school setting. It is our goal to promote the development of each child to his fullest potential. We hope to do this by providing opportunities for the child to:

- Share with his contemporaries in normal contacts of group experience.
- Find creative self-expression in play, music, art and drama.
- Learn to respect the authority of adults in addition to his/her parents
- Develop in the atmosphere of a Christian environment.

We trust each child will gain a sense of belonging, responsibility and well-being through his/her activities and relationships with others.

Children of all races, religions, creeds and nationalities are welcome to this church school.

**School Year:** Labor Day through Memorial Day

**Summer Session:** 1 Week in June

## Curriculum

Our curriculum consists of weekly units (for example: family, self, changing seasons) which are used to introduce and enhance spiritual, cognitive, language, self, social studies, math science, gross & fine motor skills. These skills are developed through free play, art, music, story reading, circle time, puzzles and playground time.

**Music** at St. Bede's is provided for the 2 year old class and older by Metro, Music Art & Movement, Inc. Their curriculum includes listening skills, singing, ear training, introduction to the staff, & various musical instruments. Children are encouraged to explore movement in a variety of rhythms and sounds. The music experience is enhanced through puppets, pictures, parachutes hands on rhythm instruments and even bubbles.

**Library Time** is on Wednesdays for children in the 3 and 4 year old classes. At St. Bede's small, yet ever growing library, the children hear a story and get to check out a book to take home.

**Computer** time is scheduled once a week for each 3 and 4 year old classroom. The software used helps introduce the children to shapes, matching, reading and math skills. It also aids in teaching the children patience and sharing.

**Socialization** skills are gained in the classroom and on the playground. Our small class size for all ages is instrumental in the children having an enjoyable and successful preschool experience.
