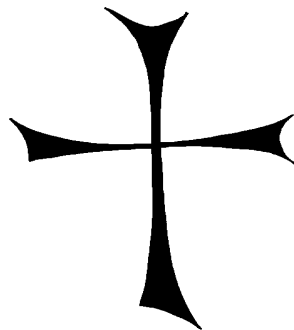

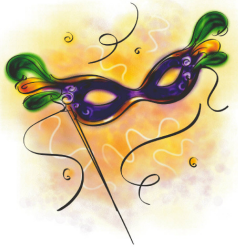

### *Epiphany Season – Living the Questions 2.0*

*Living the Questions 2.0* is a popular video and internet-based small group exploration of progressive Christianity featuring premier religious voices of our day, including acclaimed scholars, theologians and other experts. *LtQ2* strives to create an environment where participants can interact with one another in exploring what's next for Christianity. The sessions feature 20-minute video segments that include conversations with leading voices of faith, digital stories illustrating aspects of an evolving faith, and concrete spiritual practices and disciplines. The video segments will be followed by guided group discussion. Living the Questions will be offered each Sunday during the Epiphany Season
