St. Bede's Episcopal Church and the Church of our Saviour are pleased to anounce we will be hosting the 2019 *Art from the Heart* (AFTH), a joyful celebration of artists and all those who love the wonderful gifts of the soul the artists create. The event will be held at St. Bede's on Friday, October 25 (Market: Noon–5pm; Preview Party: 6–9pm) and Saturday, October 26 (10am–5pm). Please consider joining us!

Participating artists can set up Thursday, October 24, from noon until 8pm, and on Friday, October 25, from 8am until noon, after which we will open to the public. We will close at 5pm on Friday and then reopen an hour later (6pm) for the party. The public will be welcomed back in at that time to browse, shop, and enjoy drinks and appetizers. Participating artists are encouraged to open their booths for commerce during the Preview Party and are responsible for their staffing and sales during that time.

Each booth fee includes two entry tickets and two non-alcoholic drink tickets for the Preview Party. Wine, beer and additional non-alcoholic drinks will be available for a donation. Additional Preview Party entry tickets (\$10.00 each) can be purchased at the door, or in advance from Lois Shingler (Ishinglerpc@gmail.com, 770-493-1809).

We learned a lot from last November's event. We realized that we misjudged both the number of artists who would want to participate and the best booth sizes for the available space. With that in mind, all booths this year are \$100.00 and their sizes are as follows:

Booths in the Mission Wing: 8' x 9' or 5' x 15' (these are the rooms along the entrance hallway)

Booths in the Commons: 6' x 8' (this is the large open space in the center of the building)

Parish Hall: 8' x 9'

We are now accepting applications for this year's market. If you would like to be considered, please send your completed application (see page 3 of this PDF) and a check for your booth fee by September 16. We are limiting the number of artists we have in any one medium, so any artists not accepted will have their checks returned to them.

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Two new announcements for this year:

- -We are offering a select number of outside "rain-or-shine" pop-up tent locations for \$50.00. You will need to supply your own tent and it can be no larger than 10' x 10'. Additionally, electricity will not be available to these locations. These booths will be set up in St. Bede's parking lot, along the sidewalk leading to the market entrance.
- -We will be offering attendees a "passport" card which will contain numbers for each of the artists' booths. After the attendees have their cards marked by the artists, they will be able to enter a raffle for gift cards to local vendors.
